CHARGES FOR MARINA SERVICES WITH EFFECT FROM 1 FEB 2018

Dear Boaters,

Introduction

1. One of the key objectives of SAFYC is to provide affordable rates for sea sports and marina services to Club Members. From time to time, the Club's Management Committee and Management of the SAF Yacht Club will review the rates/charges taking operating cost into consideration. In doing so, marina services fees were also reviewed and benchmarked against all marina clubs.

2. Management Committee of SAF Yacht Club had approved the implementation of the following charges with effect from 1 Feb 2018 on the following:

Charges for Launching/Recovery for Wet Berth Boaters

3. Wet berth boaters who wish to up-slip their boat (subject to availability/weight) onto dry land for repair and maintenance, \$50 + 7% GST will be imposed. This charge is calculated based on one launching and recovery (1 set).

Number of launching/recovery for Dry Berth Boaters Per Month

4. Dry berth boaters will continue to enjoy launching/recovery services but will **NOT** be unlimited as in the current practice.

5. It will be free for up to a maximum of 6 sets per month. (1 set consists - launching/recovery). Beyond 6 sets, a nominal fee of \$20/set + 7% GST will apply.

Charges for Trailer Storage for Wet Berth Boaters

6. There are **WET** berth boaters who had fabricated and store their trailer's within the Club premises. With effect from 1 Feb 2018, a charge of \$80/month + 7%GST will be imposed for such storage by wet berth boaters.

7. The Club wishes to inform boaters that although the Club is able to accommodate such storage arrangement for now, we may not be able to accede to such request when the Redevelopment Works commence in the future.
