NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the:

- Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- Class Rules
- International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea
- Notice of Race (NOR) & Sailing Instruction (SI)

1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
1.3 If there is a conflict between the NoR & SI, the SI will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7.
1.4 No limit to the number and weight of crew, however all participants must adhere to their registry and insurance.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted in accordance with WS Regulation 20, Advertising Code.
2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all self-righting Keelboats in the following classes:

- PY – Performance Handicap numbers apply
- Multihull – Performance Handicap numbers apply

3.2 The allocated Handicap rating may be adjusted at the sole decision of the OA if the rating previously granted is considered to be unrealistic by the Committee with

reference to the rest of the fleet. (It is the intention of OA is to give all PY boats an opportunity to be competitive).

3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the “Entry Form” and email to seasports@safyc.org.sg

4 FEES

4.1 Entry fees for this regatta are as follows:

- Boat entry fee, including Skipper for SAFYC members: **\$180**
- Boat entry fee, including Skipper for non-members: **\$220**
- Crew registration will be at **\$100** a crew

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9 SCORING

9.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a Regatta.

9.2 A maximum of 5 races are scheduled for this Regatta;

- (a) When 3 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded if 4 or more entries are received:

International & Domestic Arrival Procedures

We require at least 48 hours advance notice of your arrival & reservations. **Please email us these documents to marina@nongsapointmarina.com.**

- Vessel Certificate, Insurance Cover Note, MMSI Certificate / Radio Licence & Photo of the vessel.
- Please complete the Indonesian arrival card (**International Arrival**) online via <https://allindonesia.imigrasi.go.id/> for all crew and passengers onboard
- Customs Vessel Declaration. New international arrival please complete here: <https://vds.beacukai.go.id/YachtOnline/login.html>.
- Passport bio-data page image of everyone onboard.
- Crew / Passenger List with Immigration stamp
- Port Clearance.

Upon arriving in Nongsa Point Marina:

- Port Health Authority will come on board to check general health conditions, medicines and boat sanitation.
- Once cleared above & approved, only then Immigration & Customs clearance will take place.
- Customs will come on board to inspect and take photographs of the navigational equipment, engines, interior & exterior of the vessel.
- No disembarking or any embarkation or leaving the premises until fully cleared by Authorities.

Requirements

- Boats must be fitted with IMO approved AIS Class A/B.
- Passport must be valid for more than 6 months.
- Foreigners must possess valid Indonesia Visa or follow the latest visa policy.
- First Aid Kit
- Boat stamp
- Indonesia Ship's Health Book / Sanitation Certificate (or will issue new one)

NOTE:

Contact Nongsa Point Marina on VHF 67 when 1-2NM distance.

The above procedures, regulations & fees are subject to changes without prior notice.

Please fly Indonesia courtesy flag, N & Q from conspicuous point when entering Indonesia waters. (N & Q for international arrival)

Original documents must be presented for inspection.

A foreign flagged vessel may stay in Indonesia up to 3 years. No chartering / commercial activities whatsoever permitted.

It's compulsory to have domestic Port Clearance for cruising in Indonesia. Get Harbourmaster & Port Health endorsement where possible or, alternatively from Village Chief / Navy / Resort / Marina you're at. Update Crew / Passenger List with Immigration if there are changes.

Visa exemption : 30 days. Not extendable.


